Opening Comments: - With the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor extending a cordial welcome to all the members attending the 10th Skill Council Meeting, whether in person or through online mode, the session commenced. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor took the opportunity to present an overview of the remarkable achievements of Shri Vishwakarma Skill University.

Following the chair's permission, the meeting officially began, and the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor was invited by Registrar to share the University's progress with all the esteemed members.

During the meeting, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor presented a glimpse of the remarkable achievements of Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU). He shared with gratitude that the university will soon be shifting to its permanent campus this year and expressed his heartfelt thanks to the entire SVSU team for their invaluable contributions. The Vice-Chancellor also acknowledged the worthy members of the Skill Council for their continuous support and valuable inputs that have driven the progress of the university.

The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor further showcased the campus design, drawing inspiration from the symbolism of Karma, represented by Arjun and Krishna. He proudly stated that SVSU is the first university in the state to successfully implement the E-Office system. The university accomplished the assessment of 1.8 lakh students from school boards and 3,000 teachers, exemplifying their commitment to quality education.

Highlighting SVSU's unique dual-integrated model of education, he emphasized the role of the Pedagogy and Capacity Department, catering to the training needs of employees from various organizations and state employees. The university has fostered collaborations with over 90 national and international industry partners, resulting in an impressive 65% placement rate for students in industries with attractive initial packages.

The eligibility for an Industry mentor may be amended such as a B.Tech with higher years of industrial experience and M.Tech with less years of experience may be amended accordingly and an Industry Research mentor may be used instead of an Industry mentor. The no. of industry mentors for a Ph.D. candidate may also be restricted to up to 3 for research on multi-disciplinary areas.
3. Provisions for the presence of an industry research mentor at the time of the final assessment of Ph.D. candidates should also be made.
4. Industry expert should also be part of RAC
5. Coursework requirements should be also clarified in these guidelines specifically for employed applicants.

6. Formation of RAC within 30 days after identification of research problem should also be rechecked.
7. Research should be aligned with industry eco-system.
8. Research guidelines for international students and the provisions of fellowship may also be incorporated.
